
# Neo Fest 2022 -25<sup>th</sup> March – 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022









### **International Day of Yoga-21st June 2022**

### FIRING CAMP 2021-21<sup>st</sup> September 2021




The 41 UP Battalion (Bulandshahar) organized the camp.




