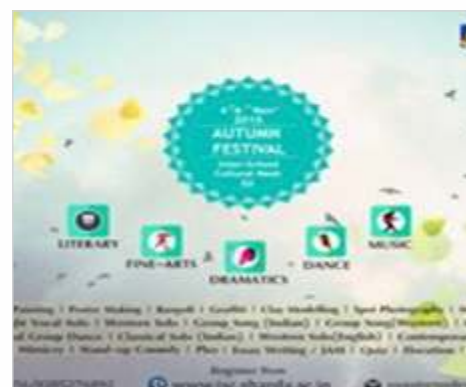
Contemporary Dance workshop (22nd October 2016)

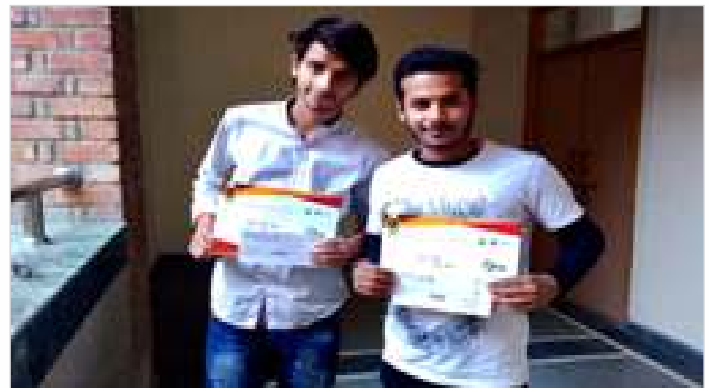
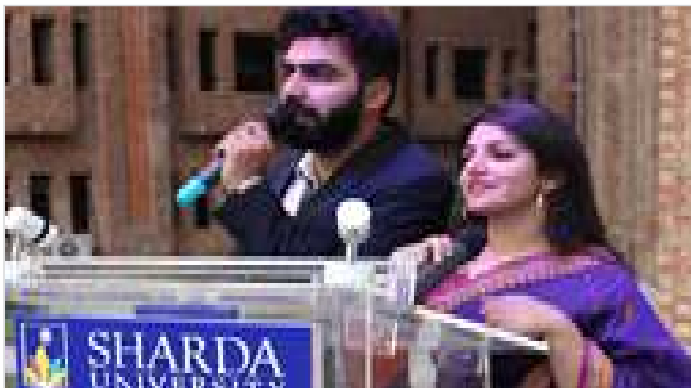
Photography Workshop on Street photography Photo Exhibition (28th March 2017)
